

Datavideo TD-1 Instruction Sheet

The Datavideo TD-1 provides tally light indication for both the cameraman and the subject. Red and Amber, front and rear facing LEDs indicate when the camera is cued (amber) or live (red).

Specifically designed for use with the RMC-140 and SE 800, the TD-1 connects to the 3.5mm Tally Out Socket, via the 50m CB-1 tally light cable.

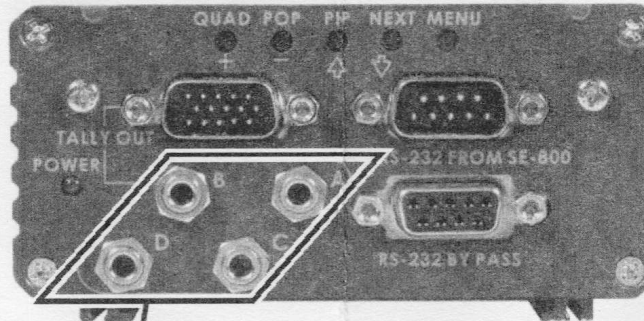
Please refer to the RMC 140 instruction manual for correct installation of the RMC 140 with the SE 800.

The TD-1 can be used with any camcorder, you do not need a professional camera with built in tally function.

Tally light definition:

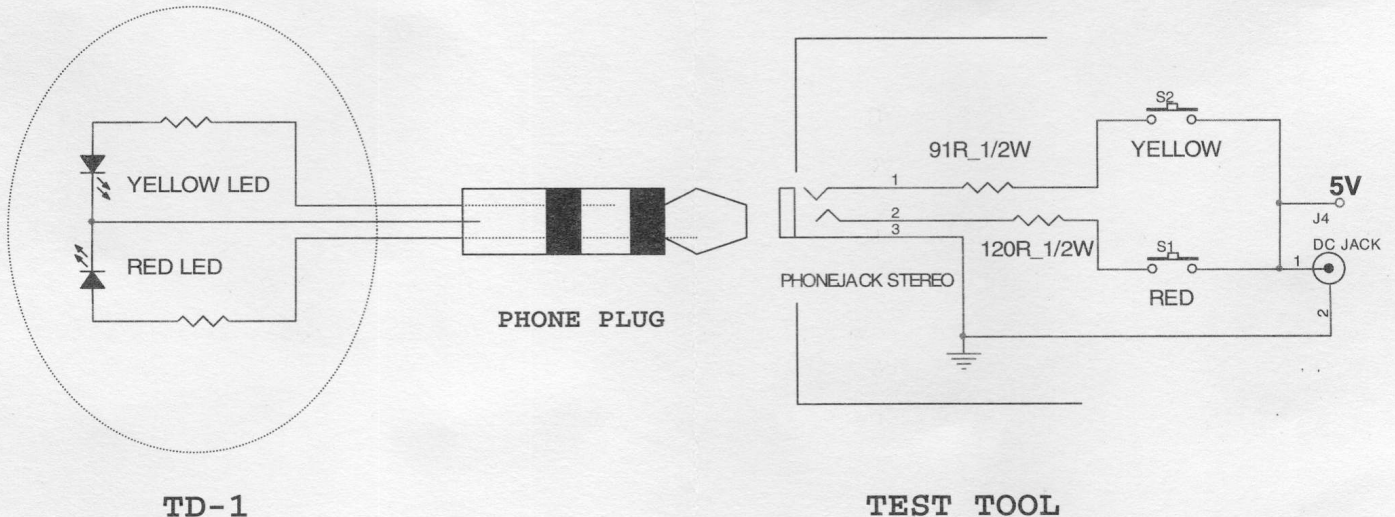
Message	On Line/On Air/Live	Stand by/Cued	Free/Safe
Light	RED	AMBER	No light

Connect the TD-1 to the RMC 140 Tally Light Output 3.5mm Jack Sockets, via the CB-1 cable.

If you want to test the TD-1, without using the RMC 140 you can use a simple test tool.
