






VM-10C Violin Microphone Cable



VM-10H Violin Microphone Clip




VT-20H/VT-22H Violin Transmitter Holder




VM-10 Wireless Transmission Illustration

- Attach VM-10M onto VM-10H.
- Clip VM-10H onto violin's tailpiece with the microphone placed over fine tuners. Ascertain the microphone tip does not extend beyond the bridge so it will not interfere with bow during performance.
- Connect VM-10M to VM-10C and to any MIPRO bodypack transmitter for a wireless transmission. (see diagram 1)



Transmitter Controls & Indicators



Power On/Off Switch

Charging Socket: Use supplied charger only.

Over Indicator:

- Fresh Battery The Power Indicator will illuminate for 1 second and extinguish after power is turned on.
- Low Battery The Power Indicator will flash continuously indicating the battery level is low and needs to be recharged within 10 minutes.

- ACT (IR) Port: Align both receiver and transmitter ACT ports within 30cm of each other when the ACT button on the receiver is pressed for a successful ACT synchronization.
 - Successful ACT syncing: The Power Indicator will illuminate for 1 second and extinguish after channels are synchronized successfully.
 - **Unsuccessful ACT syncing:** The Power Indicator will flash continuously for 5-6 seconds. Check to see if different transmitter and receiver frequency bands are used.
- Charging Indicator: Red indicator denotes charging; Green indicator denoted charged. Fully charge may take up to 3-4 hours.



Charging Method

- Power off transmitter.
- Plug the supplied charger into the AC mains input socket and then plug it into Miniature Transmitter.
- Do not use charger from other brands to avoid insufficient voltage or current.
- Do not exceed the input supply voltage as it may damage the battery charger, rechargeable battery and transmitter itself. The output of MIPRO DC power supply is 12V/0.2A.

Viewing Charging Status

- Charging: Red LED indicator.
- Charged: Green LED indicator.




Note:

Rechargeable batteries have a limited number of charge cycles and may eventually need to be replaced. Battery life and number of charge cycles vary by useage and user settings.

VT-20/VT-22 Wireless Transmission Illustration


- Mount ACT-20T(VT)/VT-22T onto hot spot of VT-20H/VT-22H.
- Height of *Adjusting Sliding Jaw (ASJ) can be adjusted by squeezing the side springs using the thumb and index finger together.
- Carefully mount VT-20H/VT-22H onto violin with thumb & index finger in one hand and the thumb & index finger in the other hand to adjust for ideal height & tension. (see diagram 2)
- VT-20/VT-22 kit is designed for performers having existing MIPRO receivers.
- VT-20 kit includes VT-20H, ACT-20T(VT) and requires VM-10H & VM-10M.
- VT-22 kit includes VT-22H, VT-22T and requires VM-10H & VM-10M.
- Forcing adjusting slide jaw up & down without pressing the side may damage the mechanical part.




VT-30/VT-50/VT-70 VT-32/VT-52/VT-72 Wireless Transmission Illustration

- Mount ACT-20T(VT)/VT-22T onto hot spot of VT-20H/VT-22H.
- Height of *Adjusting Sliding Jaw (ASJ) can be adjusted by squeezing the side springs using the thumb and index finger together.
- Carefully mount VT-20H/VT-22H onto violin with thumb & index finger in one hand and the thumb & index finger in the other hand to adjust for ideal height & tension (see diagram 3).
- VT-30 kit is designed with MIPRO ACT-311/ ACT-312 diversity receiver, VT-20H and ACT-20T(VT). Ideal for smaller crowds.
- VT-32 kit is designed with MIPRO ACT-311B/ ACT-312B diversity receiver, VT-22H and VT-22T . Ideal for smaller crowds.
- VT-50 kit is designed with MIPRO ACT-515 true diversity receiver, VT-20H and ACT-20T(VT). Ideal for medium crowds.
- VT-52 kit is designed with MIPRO ACT-515B true diversity receiver, VT-22H and VT-22T. Ideal for medium crowds.


- VT-70 kit is designed with MIPRO ACT-717/ ACT-727/ACT-747 true diversity receiver, VT-20H and ACT-20T(VT). Ideal for large crowds in large professional venues.
- VT-72 kit is designed with MIPRO ACT-717B/ ACT-727B/ACT-747B true diversity receiver, VT-22H and VT-22T. Ideal for large crowds in large professional venues.
- Forcing adjusting slide jaw up & down without pressing the side may damage the mechanical part.

(O)Correct: All the way inside.




(X) Wrong: only half way inside.

Violin Microphone Kit

VM-10 Wired Transmission Illustration

- Attach VM-10M onto VM-10H.
- Clip VM-10H onto violin's tailpiece with the microphone placed over fine tuners. Ascertain the microphone tip does not extend beyond the bridge so it will not interfere with bow during performance. (see diagram 4)
- Connect VM-10C Violin Microphone Cable onto a MIPRO MJ-53 Condenser Microphone Adaptor.
 MJ-53 provides 12V~48V DC phantom power with a XLR output to the mixer input for a wired transmission. (see diagram 4)
